1. Term 3 Message from Principal

Greetings and a warm welcome back to school to all BGPIans for Term 3! The first two terms have gone by in a flash and we are delighted to have celebrated our school's 25th Anniversary on the last day of Term 2 with a jubilant morning programme with all BGPIans followed by a grand dinner programme with all past and present BGPIans, staff, stakeholders and school partners, graced by our Guest-of-Honour, Minister of State (MOS), Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth & Ministry of Manpower, and Mayor, South East District, Mr Dinesh Vasu Dash. It was heartwarming and touching to see BGPIans gaining a deeper appreciation of our school's relatively short history while being inspired by the BGPIans who have gone before us, and the celebratory mood was combined with a great sense of pride at how far BGPS has come in such a short time. As MOS Dinesh mentioned in his speech, he was amazed at how confident, natural and articulate BGPIans were during his interactions with them, be it in formal settings or whenever he meets them in the community. This is a good checkpoint that demonstrates the effectiveness of our school's Total Curriculum as well as the efforts that have been made by all our staff over the years, to develop BGPIans to be empowered learners and persons of strength and character.

Over the first six months of 2026, we have seen many of our BGPIans developing holistically, not only in their academic pursuits, but also in their character and values through our Total Curriculum Framework. BGPIans have continued to progress through their participation in competitions like the Singapore Youth Festival Arts Presentations, the National School Games (NSG), and through our Applied Learning Programme and Learning for Life Programme in Environmental Education and Sports and aesthetics To Reinforce Values Education (STRIVE) respectively. I am happy to share that our aesthetics CCAs have done the school proud to bring in two Distinctions from the Angklung and Guzheng Ensembles, and three Accomplishments from the Chinese and Malay Dance troupes as well as Choir. It was also the first time that the Drama category for primary schools was open this year, which both our English and Tamil Drama teams participated in. I would like to specially mention our Tamil Drama team, which comprised P2 students, and were the only Tamil Language team amongst all schools to be represented in the competition. Not to be outdone, all our sports CCAs have also done well by improving in their NSG competitions year on year. While we have never placed emphasis on the results as we believe that sports and aesthetics have always been a means to developing important character values like resilience, persistence, empathy and never giving up, success through these competitions have always been a bonus and add to the positive experiences that our sports and aesthetics CCA boys and girls will remember as a hallmark of their primary school lives. As such, I am pleased to share that the Senior BGPIans in all four sports CCAs have done very well this year, with basketball and football boys rounding off the Top-8 nationally, basketball girls in the Top-12, football girls and rugby boys being 3rd and 4th in League 2 nationally, and the badminton team 2nd in League 4. Our school's efforts in environmental education have also not gone unnoticed, with the Gold Award in the National Environment Agency's Project E.C.O. Environment Protection Category being the latest in our string of environmental education accolades. Combining environmental education with Design Thinking, we also hosted the National Design Thinking Conference in our school in April this year, with a total of 31 schools and more than 200 student participants.

For the second half of the year, I would like to see BGPIans continuing to focus in their learning, not only academically but in all aspects of their holistic development as a person. Success and failures

will be part of the journey to be taken, but will be even more important to learn from mistakes, strengthen the desire to master concepts, and overcome personal setbacks through grit, determination and hard work. As our school motto says, Persevere and Succeed – all BGPians will do well to remember this by taking ownership of their own learning while also learning to help one another along the journey. In this respect, I would like to encourage all parents to partner us in our endeavor to support our BGPians' ongoing development and growth, to become better, stronger and wiser. I also wish to take this opportunity to thank all our parents, as well as my staff for working together with me in making BGPS truly an inviting home for all, and a place that is conducive for the best development of the child. I look forward to our ongoing home-school partnership as we strive to make the second half of 2026 even better than the first.
