1. Term 3 Message from Principal

Greetings and a warm welcome back to school to all BGPians for Term 3! I hope that you and your child had an enjoyable break and would like to thank you for your strong support and efforts in partnering the school in the first half of the year. Term 2 ended on a high note with an engaging and authentic Curriculum Experience (CE) Day that sought to ignite students' curiosity, promote creativity and critical thinking and encourage them to experiment and discover new learning. Middle and upper primary students got to exercise their personal ownership in choosing their preferred learning activities ranging from Eco-craft Creations to Forensic Fun, Car-Go Race and Outdoor Mathematics Trail. The event culminated in a finale concert with level cheers and performances, reinforcing the school spirit as well as the Principal's Challenge – a sports-stacking competition that requires concentration, agility, and accuracy. Our students have demonstrated curiosity and critical thinking in their learning, demonstrating their varied strengths in sports, communication, leadership, art and craft, problem-solving, and mathematical intelligence! I am grateful for the strong support of our alumni and parent volunteers, and would like to congratulate Wong Ling Ying (5 Resilience), Lin Haoze Lucas (4 Bravery) and Elizabeth Wong Anne Qii (2 Resilience) for winning the Principal's Challenge in their respective categories!

As part of the Be Digitally Lit! @ BGPS Programme, we will be introducing 3 sessions of in-curriculum foundational coding programme for Primary 2 students in Term 3. They will learn about basic concepts of coding, robotics, and their applications in daily lives through gameplay and storytelling. Students will also get to work in teams to code their robots to complete challenges. More details will be provided when the schedule is finalized.

As we begin Term 3, I would like to take this opportunity to remind all students and parents of the importance of safety within our school premises. We have seen a significant number of injury cases in the classroom, soccer field, and parade square during the previous term, primarily due to carelessness. It is crucial that our students understand the need to be mindful of their surroundings and exercise caution while moving around the school and in the classrooms. I urge all students to refrain from running in these areas and instead, walk briskly and responsibly. Additionally, I encourage parents to reinforce this message at home, emphasizing the importance of safety and responsible behavior.

As we continue to prioritize the safety and well-being of our students, I would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone that safety is a shared responsibility. In line with this, we will be conducting a schoolwide Lock-Down and Evacuation Exercise on 5 August as part of our school safety and National Education curriculum to ensure that our students are well-equipped to respond effectively in the event of an emergency, and to recognize that we must all have the will to act in an authentic situation even as we have a sense of reality of Singapore's vulnerabilities. We kindly request for your support in reinforcing these important messages with your child, and we will provide more details on the exercise closer to the date as we also commemorate Singapore's 59th National Day, 'Together, As One United People', which is the theme for this year's National Day. Here's wishing everyone an exciting and exuberant Term 3 ahead, and a great time of learning and growth in BGPS!
